TASTING NOTES:

Our 2011 Pinot Noir comes from the Willamette Valley (sourcing from the Yamhill Carlton & Chehalem Mountain sub-AVA's), harvested from the Fruit Hill and Five Mountain Vineyards. The wine spent 8 months in French Oak, imparting a slight spice and creaminess to complement the element of smokiness. A hallmark of our Pinot Noir is a touch of cigar box which is balanced with red fruits and a round flavor. Great to have by the glass, Labor pairs well with the classic, rustic flavors of harvest including Roasted Meats and Root Vegetables, but is balanced to complement Seafood dishes.
