VINTAGE & VARIETAL: 2013 Pinot Noir

TASTING NOTES:

Our 2013 Pinot Noir, sourced from within the Willamette Valley, including the Yamhill Carlton sub-AVA, harvested from the Bayliss Vineyard and in the Chehalem Mountain sub-AVA, from the Five Mountain Vineyard. The wine spent 8 months in French Oak, with 10% new barrels, resulting in a touch of cigar box and baking spice, along with a hint of Orange Peel on the nose. Flavors of Cranberry, Candied Orange Peel and Crushed Violets are found throughout the wine.

The 2013 Harvest was a balance of the highs and lows of our growing environment. With wet weather causing lower yields, a warmer and drier climate came next with a long hang on the vine, allowing for flavor concentration and feminine qualities in the wine. The 2013 vintage is a true testament to the development of a wine in the vineyard, with patience, time and attention leading to an elegant and fresh bottling.
